Hollow & Deckciting Block Care:

Recommended Use:

Hollow and Deckciting Blocks are a fantastic resource for children to learn about stability and balance.

Ensure there is plenty of free space around the block play area as the structures built may be unstable and fall over. This is an opportunity for children to learn about and manage risk.

Supervision advised. Rec 3+Yrs.

The blocks can be used inside and outside. They must be stored dry in a covered area when not in use as this will greatly prolong their lifespan.

Block Care & Cleaning:

Regularly check your blocks for any splits, breaks, missing or broken parts. If any of these issues occur remove the block immediately and repair or discard.

It is good practice to regularly sand any rough edges that occur through regular play - you could even get the children involved. After sanding the blocks should be treated with a good quality sealer. Any sealer used must be suitable for children's toys.

The best way to clean your blocks is by using a stiff brush to remove any debris and then using a small amount of soapy water to wipe them down, ensuring they are completely dry before play continues.
